**PFOA Compliance Letter**

Dear Valued Customer,

Nye Lubricants has investigated PFOA (perfluoro-octanoic acid) levels in all PTFE (polytetrafluoroethylene) currently used in our product formulations, as a thickener, additive or oil for greases. Based on the European Union REACH Annex XVII, PFOA is now considered a Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) at levels above 0.1% by weight of PFOA and its salts.

Nye will only use PTFE with levels low enough to ensure our products conform to regulatory requirements. Although this work is not a measurement of each product's complete formulation, analysis indicates PTFE would be the most significant contributor to PFOA levels.
